Competition Rules

ALL DANCING EVENTS WILL BE HELD UNDER THE RULES OF THE SOBHD

1. Any protest must be handed in writing to the appropriate committee, properly signed, accompanied by a fee of \$20.00. If protest is sustained, fee will be returned. Protests must be made immediately following posting of results.
2. Communication or attempted communication with a judge or scrutineer in respect to a competitor will result in disqualification of that competitor.
3. Only officers of the Society, the Committee members, members of the press and competitors will be allowed in the competing areas.
4. The Committee reserves the right to change any event or time schedule.
5. Sunday Dance Events: In the event of a tie for the Aggregate Trophy, dancers will be required to compete to break the tie.
6. All dancers must be registered with FUSTA and present 2010 FUSTA registration card in order to dance and receive prizes.
7. R.L.L. Open to all dancers who have not reached their seventh birthday and are California residents. Contestants must be able to complete four steps of the Highland Fling.
8. Competitors may only compete in events to which their respective birth date applies. Pre- Premier and Premier, on Sunday as of May 30, 2010, Premier on Saturday Regional Championships as of July 15, 2010.
9. To qualify for the City of Edinburgh Medal, dancer must win a first prize in the Juvenile Fling, Sword or Seann Triubhas. The dance will be drawn from one of these three dances. Total aggregate points of the judges will determine the winner.
10. Dance Steps: Beginners/ Novice: Fling, 4 steps; Sword, 2 slow, 1 quick; Seann Triubhas, 3 slow, 1 quick. Intermediate, Premier: Fling, 6 steps, Sword, 3 slow, 1 quick; Seann Triubhas, 4 slow, 2 quick; Strath & 1/2 Tulloch. National Dances : Dancers 16 & over 6 steps, all others 4 steps.
11. Prize money: 17 years and under: 1st, \$50; 2nd, \$25; 3rd, \$15; for all Sunday events. Dancers ages 18 and over: 1st, \$100; 2nd, \$75; 3rd, \$50. If there are 12 or more dancers in 17 & Under, a 4th prize of \$10; 12 or more in 18 & Over a 4th prize of \$25 will be added.

NOTE: Proof of registration (competitor number) must be presented at the gate for admission.

NOTE: Dancers winning a trophy on Saturday or Sunday morning may be required to perform in Main Arena that afternoon.
