2. Fees must accompany applications and entry forms. NO REFUNDS. Returned checks will be charged bank fees plus a \$35 service charge.
3. All application responses and competitor entries must be received by June 19, 2010.
4. Late applications, entries, field entries and competitor substitutions will not be accepted.
5. Competitor numbers, gate passes, schedules and any advance admission tickets purchased will be mailed by July 15, 2010.
6. Everyone must have a gate pass or an admission ticket to get on the field Saturday and Sunday.

CAMPING

On-Site:

Camping is permitted in designated areas only. Reservations taken for a minimum two-night stay, paid in advance. You may access the on-line reservation system between the dates of May 28 and July 1. In the event that any non-reserved campsites remain after the reservations close, these sites will be available beginning Thursday morning, July 29 at 9 a.m. on a first-come, first-served basis. Dedicated hook-ups (power and water) are very limited and must be booked for all 4 nights. Partial hook-ups (power/water and power only) are limited. Only 350 sites total are available per night. There is no sewage or gray water disposal on the site. Sanikans with washing stations will be available in the camping area Thursday to Monday morning. Restrooms and showers are available inside the Expo Center grounds from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m..

From the North, go South on Interstate 405 to the Maple Valley Highway (State Route 169) and south to Enumclaw.

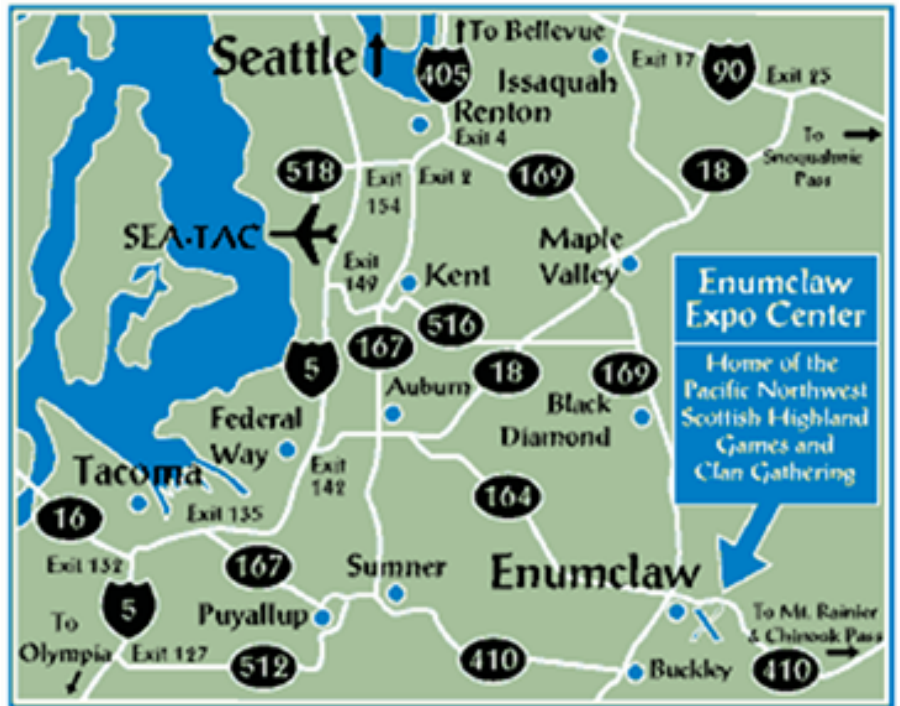
From Interstate 90, take State Route 18 to Maple Valley and then State Route 169 south to Enumclaw.

DANCING RULES

1. Competition governed by S.O.B.H.D. rules.
2. Highland steps from S.O.B.H.D. text, Nationals from B.A.T.D. S.D.T.A. and U.K.A text.
3. Age is as of each day of competition.
4. All competitors must include their FUSTA/SCOT DANCE REGISTRATION number on the entry form and must present their FUSTA or SCOTDANCE REGISTRATION CARD to receive medals or prize money, and to compete (per S.O.B.H.D.)
5. Washington State Events: Open only to Premier dancers who are residents of Washington State.
6. Classes may be combined or split at the discretion of the dancing committee.
7. Primary, Beginner, Novice, Intermediate and Premier 18 & Over classes to be split at close of entries.
8. Competitors must fill in for reels if requested.
9. First entered will be last to dance. Competitors not present when scheduled or causing delay will forfeit his/her entry in the event.
10. Competition start times are as follows:
 - Saturday:** Competition begins at 9:00 a.m.
 - Sunday:** Choreography begins at 8:30 a.m.
Washington Only begins at 9:30 a.m.
Blue Bonnets begins at 10:00 a.m.
Blue Bonnets Special begins at 1:30 p.m. (See Rule 15)
11. Choreography is open to Premier and Intermediate dancers only and must be either Highland or National in appearance, music and theme. Choreography "A" (open to individual performers) and "B" (open to groups of 2 or more) is limited to the first 15 combined total performances to enter:
 - a) **Name of Choreography dance and names of all competitors required on entry form.**
 - b) Competitors must supply their own piper, cassette or CD.
 - c) Classes may be split by age.
 - d) Length of performance should not exceed 3 minutes.
12. Aggregate trophy or plaque awarded in every class each day (except Primary per S.O.B.H.D.)
13. All dances on Saturday will count toward Saturday trophy.
14. All dances on Sunday will count toward Sunday trophy.
15. First place winners in Under 16 Blue Bonnets classes and 16&O classes will compete for perpetual trophies.
16. Any attempt to approach a judge or dance piper by any competitor or their parent may result in disqualification.
17. The decisions of the judges are final. Protests must be made in writing and in the hands of the Games Executive Secretary along with a \$25.00 fee prior to the end of the day's competition. If the protest is sustained, the fee will be returned.
18. It is the responsibility of the competitor to pick up at the Games, or request in writing by October 31, 2010, all awards. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of all awards.
19. **Competitor number, gate pass, schedule and any advance admission tickets you have purchased will be mailed by July 15, 2010. Everyone must have a gate pass or admission ticket to get on the field.**
